AISLING VINEYARD LOS CARNEROS, SONOMA COUNTY PINOT NOIR

"Aisling" is a beautiful Irish girl's name meaning "a dream" or "a vision." The Aisling Vineyard Pinot Noir is a block selection of the larger Gremlin Vineyard — a family-owned, old-vine, sustainably-farmed (non-certified) vineyard just outside the town of Sonoma. We destem the grapes to stainless steel and ferment on native yeasts for twelve days. The wine ages for eighteen months in a selection of new French oak barrels, the rest neutral oak. Black tea and peppercorns on the palate, lead to strawberry and rhubarb and crushed pepper, like chocolate covered strawberries on the finish.

Enjoyable now, best between 2024 - 2027.

Six barrels; 188 cases produced.
