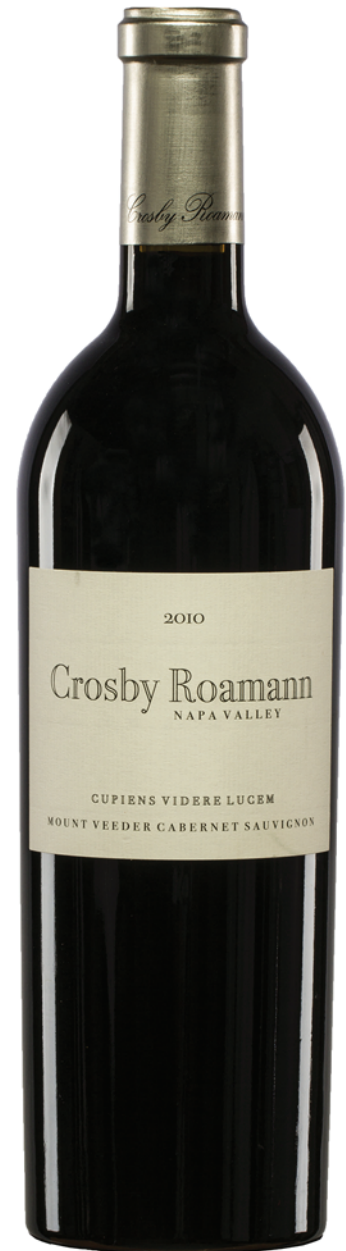

Crosby Roamann is a small winery consumed with the idea of creating honest, handmade wines. This passion stems from an age-old belief that every vineyard is special, every vintage is unique, and each wine is distinct. The process is not easy. It starts with careful vineyard selection and management, a vigilant crush, and traditional winemaking practices. It's this hands-on, labor-intensive process that ultimately creates a wine that truly has character and history - only then is a label created and a wine given the Crosby Roamann name.

This is a deliciously ripe Cabernet Sauvignon from a steeply sloping southeastern facing hillside at 1000 feet. We harvested on November 5, by hand, at dawn, with miniscule yields less than 2 tons per acre, and performed a vigorous cluster-sort prior to fermentation in a temperature controlled stainless steel tank. Maceration lasted 21 days, followed by malolactic fermentation in barrel. The wines aged for twenty months in 80% new French oak barrels.
