From a small and family owned old vine, sustainably farmed vineyard just outside the town of Sonoma. The grapes fermented on native yeasts with 50% stem inclusion. We pressed entirely by hand, and racked to 50% new French oak barrels for the completion of malolactic. The wine spent 12 months in barrel prior to racking to steel and bottling unfiltered and unfiltered. Six barrels; 148 cases produced.
