Kim's vineyard overlooking San Pablo Bay is located southeast of Carneros on the road leading down to American Canyon, sort of in a no-man's land between the better known parts of Napa Valley. We picked this vineyard ourselves, by hand, and partially destemmed the fruit to open top barrels for native primary fermentation. We pressed entirely by hand at fourteen days, and racked to 33% new French oak barrels for a natural malolactic fermentation. The wine aged for 12 months in barrel prior to racking to steel and bottling unfined and unfiltered. Three barrels produced; 75 cases.
